Access to parents to the videos used in Maths lessons

Dear parents and carers

For Maths lessons, we use the curriculum from the White Rose Maths Hub. This curriculum includes a number of 'home learning' videos to accompany each learning unit.

These videos are available for parents and carers to access so that you can see the methods that your children are learning to use for their maths.

Our teachers have adapted the curriculum to suit our children's needs and so our classes may not follow the exact order of units in the website. To help you identify which unit your child may be learning, I have attached the Maths plans for each year group.

To find a particular video:

- choose your child's year group and press FILTER. (Use 'New Schemes')
